#### INTRODUCTION

The Africa Section, of the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions, (IFLA) will host pre-conference seminar at the IFLA, World Library and Information Congress (WLIC) in Durban in 2007. The aim of the meeting is to chart a way forward for African Libraries in the post World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) era and in the context of the Millennium Development Goals.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE MEETING**

- 1) To bring together African Library leaders to deliberate on the future of libraries.
- 2) To map out strategies for creating libraries relevant to the information society.
- 3) To design contexts for engagements in order to make libraries relevant to the Millennium Development Goals, in particular, poverty alleviation.

### **PARTICIPANTS**

The meeting will be attended by Presidents of Library Associations, National Librarians, University Librarians, leading African Librarians, and other registered participants. It is anticipated that the meeting will be attended by 100 participants.

### ANTICIPATED OUTCOMES

There are two anticipated outcomes:

- 1) A statement on the position of African libraries in the context of the information society, and in relation to poverty alleviation.
- 2) A set of proposals on corrective strategies and capacity enhancement for sustainable African libraries that will be relevant to the millennium goals and in particular, poverty alleviation.
