## Recommendations from Working Group 2 made at the IME ICC2 August 18th 2004

## Working Group 2 – Corporate Names

The working group focused its attention in identifying aspects to be changed and/or incorporated to the following document:

STATEMENT OF INTERNATIONAL CATALOGUING PRINCIPLES (Draft), Frankfurt, Germany, 2003

- 1. Scope: consider that
- 1.1 We are working on principles and not on the ICC
- 1.2 These principles should replace the Paris Principles
- 1.3 Therefore, these principles must contain definitions of the terms for descriptive cataloguing as well as for subject cataloguing.
- 2. Incorporate in the body of the principles the definition of Corporate body, basing it on FRBR 3.2.6: Corporate body is "an organization or group of individuals and/or organizations acting as a unit"

The entity defined as corporate body comprises organizations and groups of persons and/or organizations identified by a particular name.

• Choice of access points: In the second paragraph of 5.1.1.1. where it says

In the case of corporate bodies as creators, this is limited...

substitute for

In the case of corporate bodies, access is limited...

• Authorized headings: change the first paragraph of 5.1.2 for: The authorized heading should identify the entity in a consistent manner. The form should be the predominant in manifestations or the <u>most well known</u> name for the users of the catalogue (e.g., conventional name)

Eliminate in the second paragraph: ..., if necessary,...

• In principle 5.4 Forms of Names for Corporate Bodies, introduce a generic concept such as

Enter a corporate body directly under the name by which it is generally identified (see AACR2 rule 24.1 A)
