What are the Digital Humanities?

“Nowadays, the term can mean anything from media studies to electronic art, from data mining to edutech, from scholarly editing to anarchic blogging, while inviting code junkies, digital artists, standards wonks, transhumanists, game theorists, free culture advocates, archivists, librarians, and edupunks under its capacious canvas.”

Digital humanities are also “a series of concrete instantiations involving money, students, funding agencies...programs, curricula...gatekeepers, and prestige. It might be more than these things, but it **cannot not** be these things.”

(Ramsay, 2011)

30 letters to and from Voltaire and 4 sheets of poems.
Collection acquired in 1945 for \$123 (roughly \$1200 today).
Creation of a digital edition.

Note: The known corpus of Voltaire's letters is comprised of over 21000, of which over 15000 are by Voltaire.


“Voltaire opened a door and I saw hundreds of papers.

--Do you have copies of your responses?

--A good number of them. It is the task of a valet whose only job it is.”


- Inconstant funding;
- ad hoc staff support;
- no formal institutional support;
- lack of transparency;
- ad hoc decision-making;
- no space;
- limited technological access;
- little guidance on data management/planning;
- informality;
- grassroots;
- little formal consideration in promotion or scholarship...

Alliance for Networking Visual Culture


