### **Country Report Sweden**

So far, there have been few activities in Sweden during 2006. That is probably due to last years changes in the Swedish Copyright Act: the parties wait and see.

#### **Copyright**

##### ***Revision of copyright law***

The INFOSOC-directive was implemented last year and came into force July 1, 2005. The Government has announced a total revision of the Swedish Copyright Act, but so far nothing has happened.

##### ***EU Digital Library Project***

As in Denmark, the Swedish Government supports the project.

#### **Legal deposit**

The Swedish Government is preparing a revision of the Legal Deposit Act. The new rules will comprise electronic documents, on the Internet, related to Sweden and/or Swedish language. The National Library of Sweden and the Swedish National Archive of Recorded Sound and Moving Images (SLBA) are co-operating in a special committee.

#### **Strategic plans for future**

The National Library of Sweden is planning to work out a strategic plan this autumn. It will, inter alia, deal with technical measures, as DRMS.
