Include

Demonstrate understanding of and commitment to inclusiveness and respect for diversity in the learning community

Explore

Discover and innovate a growth mindset developed through experience and reflection

Collaborate

Work effectively with others to broaden perspectives and work toward common goals

Engage

Demonstrate safe, legal, ethical creating and sharing of knowledge products independently while engaging in a community of practice and an interconnected world








School Library Educators as Faculty:

- Introduce new standards to school library candidates
- Connect shared foundations to other national education standards to show integrated context
- Align and map coursework to preparation standards



School Library Educators as Researchers:

- Conduct and disseminate research to inform the field
- Examine library practice informed by new standards or settings impacted by implementation
- Assist in identifying gaps in preparation programs to strengthen areas for research and development

- Professional Learning Scenarios
- Evaluation and Assessment Strategies
- Questions for the Reflective Practitioner
- Appendices and Addenda for pre-service Coursework
