\$a/8 Colour

A one-character code indicates the colour characteristics of the three-dimensional artefact and realia. The following codes are used:

a = one colour

The item is in a single colour. Does not include black-and-white.

b = black-and-white

The item is in black-and-white tones only.

c = multicoloured

The item is in more than one colour.

d = hand coloured

The item is coloured by hand.

u = unknown

v = mixed

The item or collection is in a combination of black-and-white and/or colours.

x = not applicable

The colour characteristics do not apply.

z = other

The item has colour characteristics not covered by the other defined codes. Includes stained, tinted, toned (e.g., sepia).
