








1. Seek ways to strengthen IFLA LAC, in every possible way, with the participation of Library Associations of the Region.
2. To participate actively in collaborative programs of common benefit established by IFLA-LAC in the region.
3. Incorporate a larger number of participating members of Library Associations in IFLA.
4. Give continuity to the integrated project "IMPACT OF THE COPYRIGHT LEGISLATION ON LIBRARIES IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN" to search for solutions on the issues presented in our countries.
5. Working for the adoption and implementation of the Marrakech Treaty with IFLA, national and international organisms, organizations and libraries.
6. Promote the approbation of the international instrument of Limitations and Exceptions to Copyright in favor of libraries, with national and international organisms, institutions and libraries.

7. Search for participation mechanisms of the library sector in public policies of the countries of Latin America and the Caribbean.
8. Work jointly as Library Associations of the region, to alleviate the damage caused by natural disasters and conflicts that affect the documental heritage and Library Associations.
9. Develop collaborative and integrated work with other Library Associations on the promotion and defense of libraries of the region and the Library Associations.
10. Develop individual projects with other Library Associations of the world on promotion and advocacy of associations, libraries, in accordance with the general guidelines of IFLA.
11. Other actions that are jointly considered pertinent and of common benefit for the signers and society in general.
