2016 Statement of the Treasurer

The financial result for the year 2016 shows a surplus of \in 86,678, compared to a surplus of \in 170,548 for 2015. The surplus of 2016 brings our general reserves to \in 1,204,901, and earmarked reserves to \in 53,044. This level of reserves is close to the level of reserves required under our Reserves Policy. These reserves are an important asset for IFLA to secure our work and sustainability into the future.

The total income for the year 2016 was \notin 2,927,423 compared to \notin 2,326,429 in 2015. This increase of \notin 600,994 can be mainly explained as follows:

1. increase of € 329,480 from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation for Legacy Project costs

- 2. increase of € 397,952 from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation for Key Initiatives
- 3. increase of € 57,025 for contributions from Stichting IFLA Foundation for Key Initiatives
- 4. decrease of ${\in}$ 47,088 for the IFLA WLIC result
- 5. decrease of € 68,838 in management fees charged against projects

The total expense for the year 2016 was € 2,840,745 compared to € 2,155,881 in 2015. This increase of € 684,864 can be mainly explained as follows:

1. increase of € 434,483 in expenses for Key Initiatives in particular the International Advocacy Programme

- 2. increase of € 329,480 for Legacy Project costs
- 3. decrease in staffing costs of € 38,751 mainly due to staff vacancies

Since 2012 IFLA's World Library Information Congress has been operating through IFLA Holding B.V. and its subsidiaries, of which IFLA is the sole shareholder, therefore the consolidated company results are included in the annual financial statements of IFLA. The IFLA WLIC surplus show a decreasing trend in the last 3 years ($2014: \in 126,364 - 2015: \in 55,063 - 2016: \in 7,975$). This is of some concern as the subsequent donation to Stichting IFLA Foundation (SIF) is reduced, so affecting the amount available to fund projects within SIF such as the Leaders Programme and the Trend Report.

The trend of decreasing membership income over the past few years is noted and it is important for IFLA to explore additional funding opportunities in the coming years to ensure our ongoing viability.

IFLA is very grateful to its member organizations who support us through donations and hosting activities, and to the organizations that support our initiatives and projects through grant funding.
