We need a colleague from every country who will co-ordinate their country's picture book choices. Co-ordinators will have to:

- Liaise with librarians in their country to agree how to choose their country's favourite picture books.
- Choose their country's picture books against the criteria.
- Once their selection is made the co-ordinator will
  - Provide all the information required (see accompanying Information sheet) for each book.
  - Write a review for each book (maximum 100 words in English and in the original language of the country submitting it.)
  - Obtain a high-resolution image of the book's cover (in jpeg format)
  - Check publishing and in print details.
  - Add all the details for their country and its book choices into the WTPB google form (we will send you a link and further information, once we have your details)
  - Promote the World Through Picture Book programme in their country once the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition has been completed.
- Liaise with Claire Stuckey and Annie Everall who are co-ordinating this work on behalf of the Children & Young Adult Section of IFLA
